Performing the first workshop for establishing a foresight on the additive manufacturing (AM) innovation value chain aiming for assessing the influencing factors.

Central questions of a foresight process are:

How can we shape the future of the additive manufacturing (AM) innovation system? Which aspects will we have to take into consideration for shaping the future of the AM innovation system?

What are the futures / strategies for the innovation systems of AM together with AM experts, with people affected opens our perception and include new aspects and opportunities. This co-creation process creates shared values for all participants and supports knowledge exchange.

For performing a foresight process the I AM RRI project will perform 3 European workshops

WS1: Assessing the influence on the AM innovation system (drivers, trends, obstacles, etc. on AM innovations system), which results in key factors. – conducted in Metz!

WS2: Projecting / shaping the key factors into various futures and deducing / combining consistent scenarios. – planned to take place in Spain in 10. Oct 2019

WS3: Deriving chances and opportunities and consequences based on the developed scenarios. – tbd.

Results of the foresight process will be discussed in the **Future Conference in spring 2021, Vienna.**
